ROTA CONOPS...One for the record books!

Last month we deployed 3 C-5 aircraft, 114 Airmen, and over 54 short tons of equipment from Dover to the AOR in support of the United States Army's 12th Combat Air Brigade and the 1st Air Calvary Brigade rotation.

Over the course of roughly 45 days, our team executed over 500 flying hours, moving 3,184,000 pounds of helicopters, supplies, equipment, and personnel...for a bit of perspective, 3.1 million pounds is approximately equal to 482 average size elephants or 16,000 average weight Airmen!

Our team maintained the highest EVER C-5M Logistics Departure Reliability Rate of 92.7% while sustaining an overall Mission Capable Rate of 88.5%. My hat is off to you all for a job well done. While only 114 folks were forward deployed for this swap out, it took the support of the whole wing to get them in country and postured for the best CONOP seen to date!
