I know that by now, most of you have heard that effective 11 March, TA has been suspended. I also suspect many of you saw last week's news reports of Congressional action reinstating the TA benefit. Unfortunately, the actual language of the Congressional bill may not really change anything. Then again, it might...

So what should you do? If possible, just wait a couple of months and see how this all plays out before going out-of-pocket or using your GI bill. I'm not sure what will happen in the next few months, but I believe there will be TA in FY14. It may look a little different than what we've gotten used to, but I believe it will be there. I also believe the GI Bill provides the greatest benefit for Airmen who are not currently on active duty, or for their dependents. My advice, then, is to wait and see what the new program looks like. While you're waiting, don't forget that DANTES and CLEP tests are still available at the Education Center, and they're still free!
