Construction outside the Main Gate

Wondering what the construction is just outside the main gate and how long it is going to last? I'm sure the Chief and I aren't the only ones to notice a delay getting to work in the mornings, and we are aware that the housing gate is experiencing some delays as well. So here is the scoop...The Delaware Department of Transportation (DELDOT) is resurfacing all the on and off ramps and restructuring sidewalks to bring them up to new ADA standards. What is ADA? It's the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)...a federal civil rights law prohibiting discrimination against individuals on the basis of disability.

Once the work on the sidewalks is complete, they will mill and overlay the ramps (all 4). To cut down on the delays we are currently experiencing, they plan to work at night to repave the ramps. No work will be done to the actual bridge crossing and the estimated completion date from DELDOT is 31 July.
